Amend House Bill 2846 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 4 5 changing Section 356z.25 as follows: 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.25) 7 Sec. 356z.25. Coverage for treatment of pediatric 8 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with infections and 9 streptococcal pediatric acute onset 10 neuropsychiatric syndrome. A group or individual policy of 11 accident and health insurance or managed care plan that is 12 amended, delivered, issued, or renewed after July 18, 2017 (the 13 effective date of Public Act 100-24) shall provide coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders 14 15 associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome, including, but not 16

1 limited to, the use of intravenous immunoglobulin therapy. For billing and diagnosis purposes, pediatric autoimmune 2 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 3 4 infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome 5 shall be coded as autoimmune encephalitis until the American 6 Medical Association and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services create and assign a specific code for pediatric 7 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with 8 9 streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset 10 neuropsychiatric syndrome. Thereafter, pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 11 infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome 12 13 may be coded as autoimmune encephalitis, pediatric autoimmune 14 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 15 infections, or pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric 16 syndrome.

If, at any time, the Secretary of the United States 17 Department of Health and Human Services, or its successor 18 agency, promulgates rules or regulations to be published in the 19 20 Federal Register or publishes a comment in the Federal Register or issues an opinion, guidance, or other action that would 21 require the State, pursuant to any provision of the Patient 22 Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148), 23 24 including, but not limited to, 42 U.S.C. 18031(d)(3)(B) or any 25 successor provision, to defray the cost of any coverage for 26 pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated 10100HB2846sam002 -3- LRB101 09717 SMS 60834 a

1 with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset 2 neuropsychiatric syndrome outlined in this Section, then the 3 requirement that an insurer cover pediatric autoimmune 4 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 5 infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome 6 is inoperative other than any such coverage authorized under Section 1902 of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 1396a, and 7 the State shall not assume any obligation for the cost of 8 9 coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders 10 associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute 11 onset neuropsychiatric syndrome.
