SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/30-50

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that, when a contract entered into by any State agency (currently, the Department of Transportation only) provides for mobilization payments and the contractor is using the services of a subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms requiring mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by changing Section 30-50 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 30-50. Mobilization payments.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "mobilization payment" means
 9 an advance payment for the preparatory work and operations
 10 necessary for the movement of personnel, equipment, supplies,
 11 and incidentals to a project site and for all other work or
 12 operations that must be performed or costs incurred when
- 14 (b) When a contract under this Code entered into by <u>any</u>
 15 <u>State agency the Department of Transportation</u> provides for
 16 mobilization payments and the contractor is using the services
- of a subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms
- 18 requiring mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor.
- Mobilization payments to a subcontractor shall be made on a tiered system based on the initial value of the subcontract:
- 21 Subcontract value Mobilization percentage
- 22 Less than \$10,000 25%
