SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/30-50

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that, when a contract entered into by any State agency (currently, the Department of Transportation only) provides for mobilization payments and the contractor is using the services of a subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms requiring mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
 3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
 5 changing Section 30-50 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 500/30-50)

7 Sec. 30-50. Mobilization payments.

8 (a) As used in this Section, "mobilization payment" means
 9 an advance payment for the preparatory work and operations
 10 necessary for the movement of personnel, equipment, supplies,
 11 and incidentals to a project site and for all other work or
 12 operations that must be performed or costs incurred when
 13 beginning work on a project.

14 (b) When a contract under this Code entered into by any
 15 State agency ~~the Department of Transportation~~ provides for
 16 mobilization payments and the contractor is using the services
 17 of a subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms
 18 requiring mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor.

19 Mobilization payments to a subcontractor shall be made on a
 20 tiered system based on the initial value of the subcontract:

21 Subcontract value	Mobilization percentage
22 Less than \$10,000	25%
23 \$10,000-\$19,999	20%

1	\$20,000-\$39,999	18%
2	\$40,000-\$59,999	16%
3	\$60,000-\$79,999	14%
4	\$80,000-\$99,999	12%
5	\$100,000-\$249,999	10%
6	\$250,000-\$499,999	9%
7	\$500,000-\$750,000	8%
8	Over \$750,000	7%
