1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3018

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3018 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act is
5 amended by adding Section 3.08 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 625/3.08 new)

7 Sec. 3.08. Food allergy awareness.

8 (a) A restaurant shall display a notice indicating to
9 consumers that any information regarding food allergies must be
10 communicated to an employee of the restaurant.

11 (b) An employee of a restaurant who receives allergy
12 information from a consumer shall communicate the consumer's
13 information to the restaurant's certified food service
14 sanitation manager.

15 (c) A restaurant meets the requirements of this Section if
16 the restaurant displays a notice regarding food allergies or

1 provides a statement regarding food allergies on its menu that
2 was approved in another state before the effective date of this
3 amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly.

4 (d) A multi-state business or a franchisee, as that term is
5 defined in the Franchise Disclosure Act of 1987, meets the
6 requirements of this Section if the multi-state business or
7 franchisee has an internal policy that requires a notice
8 regarding allergies to be displayed or a statement regarding
9 food allergies to be provided on the menu.

10 (e) On or before January 1, 2020, the Department of Public
11 Health shall create and make available on its website for
12 download the notice required to be displayed under subsection
13 (a) of this Section.

14 (f) From the effective date of this amendatory Act of the
15 101st General Assembly through July 1, 2020, enforcement of
16 this Section shall be limited to education and notification of
17 the requirements of this Section to encourage compliance.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
19 becoming law.".
