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1 provides a statement regarding food allergies on its menu that 2 was approved in another state before the effective date of this 3 amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly. 4 (d) A multi-state business or a franchisee, as that term is 5 defined in the Franchise Disclosure Act of 1987, meets the 6 requirements of this Section if the multi-state business or franchisee has an internal policy that requires a notice 7 regarding allergies to be displayed or a statement regarding 8 9 food allergies to be provided on the menu. 10 (e) On or before January 1, 2020, the Department of Public 11 Health shall create and make available on its website for download the notice required to be displayed under subsection 12 (a) of this Section. 13 14 (f) From the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 15 101st General Assembly through July 1, 2020, enforcement of 16 this Section shall be limited to education and notification of the requirements of this Section to encourage compliance. 17

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
