SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-710 from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-710

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning following too closely.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 11-710 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-710) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-710)

Sec. 11-710. Following too closely. (a) <u>The</u> The driver of a motor vehicle shall not follow another vehicle more closely than is reasonable and prudent, having due regard for the speed of such vehicles and the traffic upon and the condition of the highway.

The driver of any truck or motor vehicle drawing 12 (b) another vehicle when traveling upon a roadway outside of a 13 14 business or residence district and which is following another truck or motor vehicle drawing another vehicle shall, whenever 15 16 conditions permit, leave sufficient space so that an overtaking vehicle may enter and occupy such space without danger, except 17 that this shall not prevent a truck or motor vehicle drawing 18 19 another vehicle from overtaking and passing any vehicle or combination of vehicles. 20

(c) Motor vehicles being driven upon any roadway outside of a business or residence district in a caravan or motorcade whether or not towing other vehicles shall be so operated as to HB3100 - 2 - LRB101 11077 TAE 56284 b

allow sufficient space between each such vehicle or combination of vehicles so as to enable any other vehicle to enter and occupy such space without danger. This provision shall not apply to funeral processions.
