SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 75/17 new

Amends the Job Opportunities for Qualified Applicants Act. Provides that a person may not be placed on a do-not-hire list unless the person has committed an violent crime or unless the specific employment opportunity will require the person to exercise fiduciary responsibility. Requires annual reevaluation of persons on a do-not-hire list.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Job Opportunities for Qualified Applicants

 Act is amended by adding Section 17 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 75/17 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 17. Do-not-hire lists.</u>
- 8 (a) An employer or employment agency that maintains a
 9 do-not-hire list may not include an individual on that list
 10 unless the individual has committed a violent crime or unless
 11 the specific employment opportunity requires the employee to
- 12 <u>exercise fiduciary responsibility.</u>
- 13 <u>(b) An employer or employment agency that maintains a</u> 14 do-not-hire list must annually reevaluate the persons on the
- 15 list to ascertain whether the persons should remain on the
- 16 list.
- 17 <u>(c) In this Section, "violent crime" has the meaning</u>
- ascribed to that term in the Rights of Crime Victims and
- 19 Witnesses Act.
