## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 105/4.5 new

Amends the Minimum Wage Law. Provides that a nurse required to report to work, but not tasked to work or who is provided less than one-half the of the nurse's usual or scheduled day's work shall be paid for a minimum of 4 hours at the nurse's regular rate of pay. Does not apply to nurses paid on standby status. Effective January 1, 2020.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Minimum Wage Law is amended by adding Section 4.5 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 105/4.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 4.5. Reporting time pay for nurses.</u>
- 8 (a) Each workday a nurse is required to report for work and
  9 does report, but is not put to work or is furnished less than
  10 one-half the nurse's usual or scheduled day's work, the nurse
  11 shall be paid for half the usual or scheduled day's work, but
  12 in no event for less than 4 hours, at the nurse's regular rate
- of pay, which shall not be less than the minimum wage.
- 14 (b) If a nurse is required to report for work a second time

  15 in any one workday and is furnished less than 2 hours of work

  16 on the second reporting, the nurse shall be paid for 2 hours at

  17 the nurse's regular rate of pay, which shall not be less than
- 18 <u>the minimum wage.</u>
- 19 <u>(c) The reporting time pay provisions established under</u> 20 this Section are not applicable when:
- 21 (1) operations cannot commence or continue due to
  22 threats to employees or property or when recommended by
  23 civil authorities;

1	(2) public utilities fail to supply electricity,
2	water, or gas, or there is a failure in the public
3	utilities or sewer system; or
4	(3) the interruption of work is caused by an Act of God
5	or other cause not within the employer's control.
6	(d) This Section does not apply to a nurse on paid standby
7	status who is called to perform assigned work at a time other
8	than the nurse's scheduled reporting time.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
