SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/8-209.5 new

Amends the Service Obligations and Conditions Article of the Public Utilities Act. Requires a public utility to make a good faith effort to provide notice to a consumer through email or U.S. mail before assigning an account to a collection agency for non-payment of an outstanding bill. Effective January 1, 2020.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
Section 8-209.5 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/8-209.5 new)

Sec. 8-209.5. Collection agency notice. Before a public utility assigns an account to a collection agency for non-payment of an outstanding utility bill, the public utility shall make a good faith effort to provide written notice of the assignment to the consumer through email or U.S. mail.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020.
