1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

## ARTICLE 2

2           Section 5. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, and remains unexpended, at the close of  
4 business on June 30, 2019, from the appropriation heretofore  
5 made in Article 54, Section 50, of Public Act 100-0586 as  
6 amended, is reappropriated from the VW Settlement Environmental  
7 Mitigation Fund to the Environmental Protection Agency for all  
8 costs, including administrative expenses, associated with  
9 funding eligible mitigation actions that achieve reductions of  
10 emissions in accordance with the Environmental Mitigation Trust  
11 Agreement relating to the Partial Consent Decree between U.S.  
12 Department of Justice, Volkswagen AG and other settling  
13 defendants.

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## ARTICLE 99

15           Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
16 2019.
