SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Fireworks Regulation Act of Illinois. Provides that firecrackers, sky rockets, and Roman candles are not "fireworks" within the meaning of the Act.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fireworks Regulation Act of Illinois is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (425 ILCS 30/2) (from Ch. 127 1/2, par. 102)
- Sec. 2. The following words and phrases, when used in this

 Act, shall for the purpose of this Act have the following

 definition and meaning:
 - (a) The term fireworks shall mean and include any explosive composition or any substance or combination of substances, or article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect of a temporary exhibitional nature by explosion, combustion, deflagration or detonation, and shall include blank cartridges, toy cannons in which explosives are used, the type of balloons which require fire underneath to propel the same, firecrackers, torpedoes, sky rockets, Roman candles, bombs or other fireworks of like construction and any fireworks containing any explosive compound; or any tablets or other device containing any explosive substance, or containing combustible substances producing visual effects. The term "fireworks" shall not include snake or glow worm pellets; smoke devices; sparklers; trick noisemakers known as "party

- poppers", "booby traps", "snappers", "trick matches", 1 2 "cigarette loads" and "auto burglar alarms"; toy pistols, toy 3 canes, toy guns, or other devices in which paper or plastic caps containing twenty-five hundredths grains or less of 4 5 explosive compound are used, provided they are so constructed 6 that the hand cannot come in contact with the cap when in place 7 for the explosion; firecrackers, sky rockets, or Roman candles; 8 and toy pistol paper or plastic caps which contain less than 9 twenty-five hundredths grains of explosive mixture; the sale 10 and use of which shall be permitted at all times.
- 11 (b) The term "fireworks plant" shall mean and include all
 12 lands, with buildings thereon, used in connection with the
 13 manufacture or processing of fireworks, as well as storehouses
 14 located thereon for the storage of finished fireworks.
- 15 (c) The term "fireworks factory building" shall mean any 16 building or other structure in which the manufacture of 17 fireworks, or in which any processing involving fireworks is 18 carried on.
- 19 (d) The term "magazine" shall mean any building or other 20 structure used for the storage of explosive raw materials used 21 in the manufacture of fireworks.
- 22 (e) The term "Office" shall mean the Office of the State 23 Fire Marshal.
