SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends Public Act 101-7 to provide that certain grants to the Joliet Arsenal Development Authority may be used for prior year costs. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public Act
5 101-7, approved June 5, 2019, is amended by changing Section
6 45 of Article 46 as follows:

7 (P.A. 101-7, Art. 46, Sec. 45)

8 Sec. 45. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
10 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity:
