SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.73 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.66 new

Amends the School Code. With respect to school districts with more than 275,000 inhabitants, requires a school to provide written notification to the parent or guardian of any student who commits an act or acts of misconduct, and requires a copy of any statement made by the student to be provided to the parent or guardian within 24 hours after the statement has been made. Sets forth the information that must be included in the disciplinary report. Requires that a copy of the disciplinary report be provided to the parent or guardian of the disciplined student. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.73 and 34-18.66 as follows:

- 9 (a) This Section applies only to school districts with more 10 than 275,000 inhabitants.

 - (a) If a student commits an act or acts of misconduct, the student's school must provide written notification of that misconduct to the parent or quardian of the student. A copy of any statement made by the student relating to the act or acts of misconduct must be provided by the school to the parent or guardian within 24 hours after the statement has been made.
 - (b) A copy of any disciplinary report resulting from an investigation into the student's act or acts of misconduct must be provided by the school to the parent or guardian within 48 hours after the completion of the report. The disciplinary report must include the following:
