### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806.7

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the standard registration fee for passenger motor vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds shall be reduced by 50% for any vehicle owner who is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces. Effective January 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing  
5 Section 3-806.7 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.7)

7 Sec. 3-806.7. Registration fees for active duty military  
8 personnel and veterans.

9 (a) Beginning with the 2011 registration year, the standard  
10 registration fee set forth in Section 3-806 of this Code for  
11 passenger motor vehicles of the first division and motor  
12 vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000  
13 pounds and registered under Section 3-815 of this Code, shall  
14 be reduced by 50% for any Illinois vehicle owner who was on  
15 active duty as a member of the Armed Forces of the United  
16 States and stationed outside of the United States for a period  
17 of 90 days or longer during the preceding registration year.

18 (b) Illinois residents who are members of the Armed Forces  
19 of the United States and who have been stationed outside of the  
20 United States for a period of 6 months or longer, and who  
21 placed their registered motor vehicle in storage during the  
22 time they served abroad, shall be entitled to credit for the  
23 unused portion of that registration when they renew the

1 registration of that vehicle upon their return to the United  
2 States. For each month or part thereof that the vehicle was in  
3 storage and had current registration, the member of the armed  
4 forces shall receive one month of registration without charge.

5 (c) Beginning with the 2017 registration year, the standard  
6 registration fee set forth in Section 3-806 of this Code for  
7 passenger motor vehicles of the first division and motor  
8 vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000  
9 pounds and registered under Section 3-815 of this Code, shall  
10 be waived for the year following the return of any Illinois  
11 vehicle owner who is a member of the active-duty or reserve  
12 component of the United States Armed Forces who can provide  
13 proof of serving in a combat mission. Nothing in this  
14 subsection is applicable to the additional fees incurred by  
15 specialty, personalized, or vanity license plates.

16 (d) Beginning with the 2022 registration year, the standard  
17 registration fee under Section 3-806 for passenger motor  
18 vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second  
19 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds and registered  
20 under Section 3-815 shall be reduced by 50% for any vehicle  
21 owner who has been identified as a veteran under subsection (e)  
22 of Section 6-106. Nothing in this subsection prevents the  
23 application of the registration fee waiver provided under  
24 subsection (c).
