SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.13

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that money in the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund shall be paid as grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc. for, among other purposes, building and maintaining a museum. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 3-699.13 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.13)

7 Sec. 3-699.13. Illinois State Police Memorial Park license
8 plates.

9 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in
10 the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue
11 special registration plates designated as Illinois State
12 Police Memorial Park license plates to active or retired law
13 enforcement officers or their family members, surviving family
14 members of deceased law enforcement officers, and members of or
15 donors to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation. The
16 special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only
17 to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles over
18 150cc, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not
19 more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall
20 expire according to the multi-year procedure established by
21 Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

22 (b) The design and color of the plates shall be wholly
23 within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary

1 may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as
2 vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section
3 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or
4 decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.

5 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$25 fee for original
6 issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee, if
7 applicable. Of this fee, \$10 shall be deposited into the
8 Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund and \$15 shall be
9 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate
10 Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$25 fee, in
11 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.
12 Of this fee, \$23 shall be deposited into the Illinois State
13 Police Memorial Park Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the
14 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

15 (d) The Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund is created
16 as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the
17 Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund shall be paid, subject
18 to appropriation by the General Assembly and distribution by
19 the Secretary, as grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage
20 Foundation, Inc. for building and maintaining a memorial and
21 park and museum, holding an annual memorial commemoration,
22 giving scholarships to children of State police officers killed
23 or catastrophically injured in the line of duty, and providing
24 financial assistance to police officers and their families when
25 a police officer is killed or injured in the line of duty.
