

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 HB4680

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Local Government Business Anti-Poaching Act. Provides that no municipality or county shall offer any incentive after the effective date of the Act to a business or corporation to move its headquarters located in Illinois, or any part of its business located in Illinois, farther than 10 miles away from the current location at the time of the offering of the incentive. Defines "incentive". Limits home rule powers. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Local

  Government Business Anti-Poaching Act.
- Section 5. Definition. As used in this Act, "incentive" 6 7 means any economic, financial benefit, or other incentive, 8 including, but not limited to, those authorized under the 9 Economic Development for a Growing Economy Tax Credit Act, the Property Tax Code, the Counties Code, the Illinois Municipal 10 (including, but not limited to, the Tax Increment 11 Allocation Redevelopment Act), or any other provision of law 12 13 authorizing abatements, credits, or tax or fee reductions.
- Illinois Section 10. 14 business poaching prohibited. 15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no municipality or 16 county shall offer any incentive after the effective date of this Act to a business or corporation to move its headquarters 17 18 located in Illinois, or any part of its business located in Illinois, farther than 10 miles away from the current location 19 at the time of the offering of the incentive. 20
- 21 Section 15. Home rule. The regulation of offering

- incentives for a business or corporation to move its
  headquarters located in Illinois, or any part of its business
  located in Illinois, further than 10 miles away from the
  current location are exclusive powers and functions of the
  State. A home rule unit may not regulate such matters. This Act
  is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and functions
  under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the
  Illinois Constitution.
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 10 becoming law.
