SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/27-3

from Ch. 122, par. 27-3

Amends the School Code. Provides that a pupil enrolled in the elementary grades in a public school or other educational institution supported or maintained in whole or in part by public funds shall be required to memorize a passage from the Declaration of Independence prior to completing fifth grade. Inserts the passage from the Declaration of Independence that is required to be memorized. Allows a school or other institution to excuse a pupil from this requirement if the pupil receives special education services and cannot complete this requirement.

AN ACT concerning education. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 4
- 27-3 as follows: 5
- (105 ILCS 5/27-3) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-3) 6
- 7 Sec. 27-3. Patriotism and principles of representative
- government; proper use of flag; method of voting; government -8
- 9 Proper use of flag - Method of voting - Pledge of Allegiance;
- 10 Declaration of Independence.
- 11 (a) American patriotism and the principles representative government, as enunciated in the American
- Declaration of Independence, the Constitution of the United 13
- 14 States of America and the Constitution of the State of
- Illinois, and the proper use and display of the American flag, 15
- shall be taught in all public schools and other educational 16
- institutions supported or maintained in whole or in part by 17
- public funds. No student shall receive a certificate of 18
- 19 graduation without passing a satisfactory examination upon
- 20 such subjects.

- 21 Instruction shall be given in all such schools and
- 22 institutions in the method of voting at elections by means of
- the Australian Ballot system and the method of the counting of 23

2 (b) The Pledge of Allegiance shall be recited each school
3 day by pupils in elementary and secondary educational
4 institutions supported or maintained in whole or in part by
5 public funds.

Prior to completing fifth grade, a pupil enrolled in the elementary grades in a public school or other educational institution supported or maintained in whole or in part by public funds shall be required to memorize the following passage from the Declaration of Independence:

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.--That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed".

A school or other institution may excuse a pupil from this requirement if the pupil receives services under Article 14 of this Code and cannot complete this requirement.
