#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

230 ILCS 40/65

Amends the Video Gaming Act. Provides that Boone County, Winnebago County, and municipalities wholly or partially contained within those counties may not impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal in excess of \$250 per year for a video gaming terminal operating within Boone County or Winnebago County (rather than the City of Rockford may not impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal in excess of \$250 per year). Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Video Gaming Act is amended by changing  
5 Section 65 as follows:

6 (230 ILCS 40/65)

7 Sec. 65. Fees. Except as provided in this Section, a  
8 non-home rule unit of government may not impose any fee for the  
9 operation of a video gaming terminal in excess of \$25 per year.  
10 Boone County, Winnebago County, and municipalities wholly or  
11 partly contained within Boone County or Winnebago County ~~The~~  
12 ~~City of Rockford~~ may not impose any fee for the operation of a  
13 video gaming terminal in excess of \$250 per year for a video  
14 gaming terminal operating within Boone County or Winnebago  
15 County.
