SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Counties Code. Changes definitions of "population" to be the total number of inhabitants according to last preceding federal decennial census (rather than number of inhabitants or number of persons). Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Adds a definition of "population" in the general definition Section.

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1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing 5 Sections 2-3001 and 6-31002 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/2-3001) (from Ch. 34, par. 2-3001)

Sec. 2-3001. Definitions. As used in this Division, unless
the context otherwise requires:

9 a. "District" means a county board district established as10 provided in this Division.

b. "County apportionment commission" or "commission" means the county clerk, the State's Attorney, the Attorney General or his designated representative and the chairmen of the county central committees of the first leading political party and the second leading political party as defined in Section 1-3 of The Election Code.

17 c. "Population" means the <u>total</u> number of inhabitants 18 <u>according to</u> as determined by the last preceding federal 19 decennial census.

d. "Member" or "board member" means a person elected toserve on the county board.

Sec. 6-31002. Definitions. As used in this Division, unless
the context otherwise requires:

Comptroller" means the Comptroller of the State of
 Illinois;

3. "Funds and accounts" means all funds of a county derived
from property taxes and all funds and accounts derived from
sources other than property taxes, including the receipts and
expenditures of the fee earnings of each county fee officer;

4. "Audit report" means the written report of the auditor or auditors and all appended statements and schedules relating thereto, presenting or recording the findings of an examination or audit of the financial transactions, affairs and condition of a county;

16 5. "Population" means the <u>total</u> number of <u>inhabitants</u> 17 persons residing in a county according to the last preceding 18 federal decennial census;

6. "Auditor" means a licensed certified public accountant, 19 as that term is defined in Section 0.03 of the Illinois Public 20 21 Accounting Act, or the substantial equivalent of a licensed 22 CPA, as provided under Section 5.2 of the Illinois Public 23 Accounting Act, who performs an audit of county financial statements and records and expresses an assurance or disclaims 24 25 an opinion on the audited financial statements; "auditor" does 26 not include a county auditor elected or appointed under

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1 Division 3-1 of the Counties Code.

7. "Generally accepted accounting principles" means
 accounting principles generally accepted in the United States.

8. "Generally accepted auditing standards" means auditing
standards generally accepted in the United States.

7 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 8 changing Section 1-1-2 as follows:

9 (65 ILCS 5/1-1-2) (from Ch. 24, par. 1-1-2)

10 Sec. 1-1-2. Definitions. In this Code:

11 (1) "Municipal" or "municipality" means a city, village, or incorporated town in the State of Illinois, but, unless the 12 context otherwise provides, "municipal" or "municipality" does 13 14 not include a township, town when used as the equivalent of a 15 township, incorporated town that has superseded a civil township, county, school district, park district, sanitary 16 district, or any other similar governmental district. If 17 "municipal" or "municipality" is given a different definition 18 in any particular Division or Section of this Act, that 19 20 definition shall control in that division or Section only.

(2) "Corporate authorities" means (a) the mayor and aldermen or similar body when the reference is to cities, (b) the president and trustees or similar body when the reference is to villages or incorporated towns, and (c) the council when 1 the reference is to municipalities under the commission form of 2 municipal government.

3 (3) "Electors" means persons qualified to vote for elective4 officers at municipal elections.

5 (4) "Person" means any individual, partnership, 6 corporation, joint stock association, or the State of Illinois 7 or any subdivision of the State; and includes any trustee, 8 receiver, assignee, or personal representative of any of those 9 entities.

10 (5) Except as otherwise provided by ordinance, "fiscal 11 year" in all municipalities with fewer than 500,000 12 inhabitants, and "municipal year" in all municipalities, means the period elapsing (a) between general municipal elections in 13 14 succeeding calendar years, or (b) if general municipal 15 elections are held biennially, then between a general municipal 16 election and the same day of the same month of the following 17 calendar year, and between that day and the next succeeding general municipal election, or (c) if general municipal 18 elections are held quadrennially, then between a general 19 municipal election and the same day of the same month of the 20 following calendar year, and between that day and the same day 21 22 of the same month of the next following calendar year, and 23 between the last mentioned day and the same day of the same 24 month of the next following calendar year, and between the last 25 mentioned day and the next succeeding general municipal 26 election. The fiscal year of each municipality with 500,000 or

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1 more inhabitants shall commence on January 1.

2 (6) Where reference is made to a county within which a 3 municipality, district, area, or territory is situated, the 4 reference is to the county within which is situated the major 5 part of the area of that municipality, district, area, or 6 territory, in case the municipality, district, area, or 7 territory is situated in 2 or more counties.

8 (7) Where reference is made for any purpose to any other 9 Act, either specifically or generally, the reference shall be 10 to that Act and to all amendments to that Act now in force or 11 that may be hereafter enacted.

12 (8) Wherever the words "city council", "aldermen", 13 "commissioners", or "mayor" occur, the provisions containing 14 these words shall apply to the board of trustees, trustees, and 15 president, respectively, of villages and incorporated towns 16 and councilmen in cities, so far as those provisions are 17 applicable to them.

18 (9) The terms "special charter" and "special Act" are 19 synonymous.

(10) "General municipal election" means the biennial regularly scheduled election for the election of officers of cities, villages, and incorporated towns, as prescribed by the general election law; in the case of municipalities that elect officers annually, "general municipal election" means each regularly scheduled election for the election of officers of cities, villages, and incorporated towns.
