SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2705/2705-605

Amends the Department of Transportation Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that the Department of Transportation shall update its policy for providing notification of construction projects to the public. Provides that the policy shall include a requirement that the Department contact the highway commissioner located in each Department district that will be impacted by a proposed construction project. Provides that the policy shall be completed and published on the Department's Internet website by January 1, 2021. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Transportation Law of the
Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing
Section 2705-605 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2705/2705-605)

8 Sec. 2705-605. Construction projects; notification of the 9 public.

(a) The Department shall develop and publish an updated $\frac{1}{2}$ 10 policy for the notification of members of the public prior to 11 the commencement of construction projects which impact their 12 13 communities. The policy shall include procedures for ensuring 14 that the public is informed of construction projects, excluding emergency projects, which are estimated to require the closure 15 16 of a street or lane of traffic for a period longer than 5 17 consecutive business days. The policy shall include procedures for the notification of local public officials, including the 18 19 highway commissioner in each Department district that will be impacted by the construction projects, and affected businesses 20 21 of affected communities and shall provide the local public 22 officials the opportunity to request a meeting with the Department prior to the initiation of the closure. 23

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1 (b) The policy shall <u>include a requirement that the</u> 2 <u>Department contact the highway commissioner located in each</u> 3 <u>Department district that will be impacted by a proposed</u> 4 <u>construction project. The policy shall</u> be completed and 5 published on the Department's Internet website by January 1, 6 2021 2013.

7 (c) The Department shall work with affected stakeholders, 8 including residents, businesses, and other community members, 9 before and during construction by considering various methods 10 to mitigate and reduce project impacts to better serve those 11 directly impacted by the improvement. Those methods could 12 include, but need not be limited to, detour routing and 13 temporary signage.
