SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/3-103 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 3-103 40 ILCS 5/4-103 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 4-103

Amends the Downstate Police and Downstate Firefighter Articles of the Illinois Pension Code. In the definition of "municipality", adds a requirement that, for a fund established on or after the effective date of the amendatory Act, the governing body of the city, village, incorporated town, or fire protection district must have adopted a resolution or ordinance authorizing the establishment of a fund under the Article. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing

 Sections 3-103 and 4-103 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/3-103) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 3-103)
- 7 Sec. 3-103. Municipality. "Municipality": (1) Any city,
- 8 village or incorporated town: (A) with $\frac{1}{2}$ 5,000 or more but
- 9 less than 500,000 inhabitants, as determined from the United
- 10 States Government statistics or a census taken at any time by
- 11 the city, village or incorporated town, and (B) for a fund
- 12 established on or after the effective date of this amendatory
- Act of the 101st General Assembly, the governing body of which
- 14 <u>has adopted a resolution or ordinance authorizing the</u>
- establishment of a fund under this Article; and (2) any city,
- village or incorporated town of less than 5,000 inhabitants
- which, by referendum held under Section 3-145 adopts this

- Sec. 4-103. Municipality. "Municipality": (1) Any city,
- 22 township, village or incorporated town: (A) with of 5,000 or

more but less than 500,000 inhabitants, and any fire protection 1 2 district having any full-time paid firefighters, and (B) for a 3 fund established on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly, the governing 4 5 body of the city, township, village, incorporated town, or fire protection district has adopted a resolution or ordinance 6 7 authorizing the establishment of a fund under this Article, 8 and (2) any city, village, incorporated town or township of 9 less than 5,000 inhabitants having a full-time paid fire 10 department which adopts the provisions of this article pursuant 11 to the provisions of Section 4-141. The term "city council" or 12 "board of trustees" includes the board of trustees of a fire 13 protection district and the board of town trustees or other 14 empowered to draft the tentative budaet 15 appropriation ordinance and the electors of such a township 16 acting at the annual or special meeting of town electors.
