SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

775 ILCS 5/3-102.2 new

Amends the Real Estate Transactions Article of the Illinois Human Rights Act. Provides that it is a civil rights violation for a commercial residential property owner to discriminate against a housing grant recipient on the basis of credit score or debt obligation. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning human rights.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Human Rights Act is amended by 5 adding Section 3-102.2 as follows:

6 (775 ILCS 5/3-102.2 new)

Sec. 3-102.2. Credit score or debt obligation. It is a civil rights violation for a commercial residential property owner to discriminate against a housing grant recipient on the basis of credit score or debt obligation.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
