### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 205/9.39 new

Amends the Board of Higher Education Act. Provides that, on or before July 1, 2021, the Board shall create a public institutions of higher education informational application for phones and tablets, and, in the Board's discretion, other electronic devices. Provides that the informational application shall include, but is not limited to, admission procedures, website links, and other information as determined by each public institution of higher education. Provides that each public institution of higher education shall be given access and control of its own content in the informational application and shall be responsible for updating its own information. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 9.39 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 205/9.39 new)

7 Sec. 9.39. Public college and university informational  
8 application. On or before July 1, 2021, the Board shall create  
9 a public institutions of higher education informational  
10 application for phones and tablets, and, in the Board's  
11 discretion, other electronic devices. The informational  
12 application shall include, but is not limited to, the following  
13 information concerning each public institution of higher  
14 education:

15 (1) Admission procedures.

16 (2) Website link.

17 (3) Other information as determined by each public  
18 institution of higher education.

19 Each public institution of higher education shall be given  
20 access and control of its own content in the informational  
21 application and shall be responsible for updating its own  
22 information.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
2           becoming law.
