New Act

Creates the Affordable Medical Equipment Act. Provides that a physician licensed under the Medical Practice Act of 1987 or a hospital licensed or organized under the Hospital Licensing Act or the University of Illinois Hospital Act shall not sell medical equipment for more than the suggested retail value.

1 AN ACT concerning health.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Affordable Medical Equipment Act.

6 Section 5. Sale of medical equipment. A physician licensed
7 under the Medical Practice Act of 1987 or a hospital licensed
8 or organized under the Hospital Licensing Act or the University
9 of Illinois Hospital Act shall not sell medical equipment for
10 more than the suggested retail value.
