A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$650,000,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Technology
7 Management Revolving Fund to the Department of Innovation and
8 Technology for administrative and program expenses, including
9 prior years' costs.

10 Section 10. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Technology,
12 Education, and Cybersecurity Fund to the Department of
13 Innovation and Technology for all costs associated with the
14 Cybersecurity Liaison Program.

15 Section 15. The amount of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology for all
18 costs associated with the Illinois Century Network and
19 broadband projects.

1 Section 20. The amount of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology for all
4 costs associated with the Illinois Longitudinal Data System
5 2.0.

6 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
7 2020.
