4 Section 115. The sum of \$393,700, or so much thereof as may

15 University of Illinois.

16 Section 125. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, is appropriated from the Athletics Supervision
18 and Regulation Fund to the Department of Financial and
19 Professional Regulation for all costs associated with
20 administration of the Boxing and Full-contact Martial Arts Act.

21 Section 130. The sum of \$1,289,700, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Compassionate Use
2 of Medical Cannabis Fund to the Department of Financial and
3 Professional Regulation for all costs associated with
4 operational expenses of the department in relation to the
5 regulation of medical cannabis.

6 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
7 2020.
