

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 HB5797

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

735 ILCS 5/2-2302 new

Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Provides that, unless the inclusion of sensitive data is required by law or rule, if a party receiving money from a settlement is a minor or a person with a disability, or was a minor when the action was filed, the terms of the settlement shall be sealed or the settlement shall redact sensitive information, as the court in its discretion shall rule in order to protect the interests of the party receiving the settlement money.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding Section 2-2302 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/2-2302 new)
- 7 Sec. 2-2302. Privacy of information in certain settlements. Unless the inclusion of sensitive data is required 8 by law or rule, if a party receiving money from a settlement is a minor or a person with a disability, or was a minor when the 10 action was filed, the terms of the settlement shall be sealed 11 12 or the settlement shall redact sensitive information, as the court in its discretion shall rule in order to protect the 13 14 interests of the party receiving the settlement money. As used in this Section, "sensitive information" includes: 15
- 16 <u>(1) personal identity information as defined in</u>
  17 Supreme Court Rule 138; and
- 18 (2) the birth date, home address, and name of any
  19 person who was a minor when the action was filed.
