## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT HC0001

Introduced 1/9/2019, by Rep. Anthony DeLuca

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Prohibits a person from serving as a Representative for more than 3 terms of office that begin on or after the date that the Constitutional Amendment is declared adopted. Prohibits a person from serving as a Senator for more than 3 terms of office that begin on or after the date that the Constitutional Amendment is declared adopted. Applies to the election of General Assembly members in the first general election to occur after the Amendment is declared adopted and thereafter. Specifies that it does not affect the terms of members elected before the amendment is declared adopted. Effective upon being declared adopted.

11	THE LEGISLATURE
12	(ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new)
13	SECTION 2.5. TERM LIMITS
14	(a) A person may not serve as a Representative for more
15	than 3 terms of office that begin on or after the date that
16	this Section is declared adopted.
17	(b) A person may not serve as a Senator for more than 3
18	terms of office that begin on or after the date that this
19	Section is declared adopted.
20	(c) A person is considered to serve a term of office for
21	the purpose of this Section if the person is elected or
22	appointed to serve any portion of the term.

This Constitutional Amendment takes effect upon being declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois Constitutional Amendment Act and applies to the election of members of the General Assembly in the first general election to occur after this Amendment is declared adopted and thereafter. This Constitutional Amendment does not, however, affect the terms of members of the General Assembly elected before this amendment is declared adopted.
