1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, The worst events of the Twentieth Century were 2 3 inextricably connected with the crimes of Anti-Semitism; and 4 WHEREAS, It is the duty of American citizens, inhabitants 5 of a land of the free, to totally oppose Anti-Semitism wherever 6 it is seen, heard, or found; and 7 WHEREAS, Words of Anti-Semitism were recently spoken by an 8 elected member of the United States Congress, Congresswoman 9 Ilhan Omar of Minnesota; therefore, be it 10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 11 HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 12 we condemn words of Anti-Semitism wherever they are written or 13 spoken, especially when they are written or spoken by the holder of an office of trust under the laws of the United 14 States; and be it further 15 16 RESOLVED, That we name Congresswoman Ilhan Omar as the 17 speaker of these words; and be it further 18 RESOLVED, That any condemnation of these words should 19 specifically enumerate their Anti-Semitic content and condemn the continued existence of Anti-Semitism; and be it further 20

- 1 RESOLVED, That we urge all of the communities represented
- 2 by all American lawmakers to unite in their opposition to
- 3 Anti-Semitism; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to
- 5 the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives Nancy
- 6 Pelosi and to each member of the Illinois Congressional
- 7 Delegation.
