HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The National Day of Prayer is an annual observance 3 held on the first Thursday of May, inviting people of all 4 faiths to pray for the nation; it was created in 1952 by a 5 joint resolution of the United States Congress and signed into 6 law by President Harry S. Truman; and

7 WHEREAS, It exists to communicate with every individual the 8 need for personal repentance and prayer, to create appropriate 9 materials, and to mobilize people to intercede for America's 10 leaders and its families; and

11 WHEREAS, Because of the faith of many of our founding 12 fathers, public prayer and national days of prayer have a 13 long-standing and significant history in American tradition; 14 and

15 WHEREAS, In 1988, the law was amended and signed by 16 President Reagan, permanently setting the day as the first 17 Thursday of every May; each year, the president signs a 18 proclamation, encouraging all Americans to pray on this day; 19 last year, all 50 state governors plus the governors of several 20 U.S. territories signed similar proclamations; and

21 WHEREAS, Like Thanksgiving and Christmas, this day is
