2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 534 by replacing					
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:					
4	"Section 5. The Department of Labor Law of the Civil					
5	Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section					
6	1505-215 as follows:					
7	(20 ILCS 1505/1505-215 new)					
8	Sec. 1505-215. Commission on Diversity in Active					
9	Apprenticeship Programs Approved by the United States					
10	Department of Labor.					
11	(a) There is created within the Department the Commission					
12	on Diversity in Active Apprenticeship Programs Approved by the					
13	United States Department of Labor to increase minority					
14	participation in active apprentice programs in Illinois that					
15	are approved by the United States Department of Labor. The					
16	Commission shall identify barriers to minorities gaining					

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1	access to construction careers and make recommendations to the
2	Governor and the General Assembly for policies to remove those
3	barriers.
4	(b) The Commission shall consist of 21 members, appointed
5	by the Governor as follows:
6	the Director of Labor or his or her designee who shall
7	serve as chairperson of the Commission;
8	the Director of Commerce and Economic Opportunity or
9	his or her designee;
10	the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Illinois
11	State Toll Highway Authority or his or her designee;
12	the Executive Director of the Capital Development
13	Board or his or her designee;
14	the Secretary of Transportation or his or her designee;
15	six members of the Senate recommended by the Senate
16	President, which must include at least one
17	African-American Senator and one Hispanic Senator;
18	six members of the House of Representatives
19	recommended by the Speaker of the House, which must include
20	at least one African-American Representative and one
21	Hispanic Representative; and
22	four persons from a statewide labor organization
23	representing more than one international union.
24	(c) The Commission shall meet no less than 4 times each
25	year, and shall at least annually make recommendations to the
26	Department, the Governor, and the General Assembly. These

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1	recommendations sha	ll include	short-term	and lo	ng-term
2	solutions, and sha	ll include	suggestions	for m	inority
3	inclusion in public w	orks projects	<u>.</u>		
4	(d) The Departme	ent shall pr	ovide adminis	strative	support
5	and staffing for the	Commission.	The Departmen	t may hir	<u>e staff</u>
6	to perform outread	h in prom	oting divers	ity in	active
7	apprenticeship proq	rams approv	ed by the	United	States
8	Department of Labor.				
9	(e) At the reque	est of the C	ommission, ra	cial and	gender
10	workforce diversity	information	shall be p	rovided	to the
11	Commission by contrac	tors receivin	ng State or ot	her publi	<u>c funds</u>
12	and by labor unions w	ith members	working on pr	ojects re	ceiving
13	<u>State or other public</u>	funds.			

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
