AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Local Government Officer Compensation Act is
amended by adding Section 25 as follows:

7 Sec. 25. Elected official salary. Notwithstanding the provision of any other law to the contrary, an elected officer 8 9 of a unit of local government that is a participating employer 10 under the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund shall not receive any salary or other compensation from the unit of local 11 government if the member is receiving pension benefits from the 12 Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund under Article 7 of the 13 14 Illinois Pension Code for the elected official's service in that same elected position. If an elected officer is receiving 15 16 benefits from the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General 17 Assembly, the elected official's salary and compensation shall 18 19 be reduced to zero at the beginning of the member's next term if the member is still receiving such pension benefits. 20

21 Section 10. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
22 4-10005 as follows:

2	Sec. 4-10005. County board salaries. Notwithstanding
3	Section 4-10001, a member of a county board shall not receive
4	any salary or other compensation from the county if the member
5	is receiving pension benefits from the Illinois Municipal
6	Retirement Fund under Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code
7	for the member's service as a county board member. If a member
8	of a county board is receiving benefits from the Illinois
9	Municipal Retirement Fund on the effective date of this
10	amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly, the member's
11	salary and compensation shall be reduced to zero at the
12	beginning of the member's next term if the member is still
13	receiving pension benefits from the Illinois Municipal
14	Retirement Fund for service as a county board member.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 16 becoming law.
