## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 625/3.7

Amends the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act. Prohibits a public health district from regulating the preparing and serving of food in a private residential leasehold that is prepared by or for the lessees and consumed by the lessees and their guests.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act is
amended by changing Section 3.7 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 625/3.7)

7 Sec. 3.7. Communal kitchen in private residential8 leasehold.

9 (a) As used in this Section, "private residential 10 leasehold" means a private residential structure not open to 11 the public which is leased to more than one person and contains 12 a communal kitchen used by the lessees and guests of the 13 lessees.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, neither the Department of Public Health<u>, nor</u> the health department of a unit of local government<u>, nor a public health district</u> may regulate the preparing and serving of food in a private residential leasehold that is prepared by or for the lessees and consumed by the lessees and their guests.

20 (c) This Section does not apply to regulation of private 21 residential leaseholds in municipalities with a population 22 greater than 1,000,000.
