A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$636,763,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7 to the Department of Human Services for ordinary and contingent  
8 expenses of the department and for student, member or inmate  
9 compensation expenses of the department for the fiscal year  
10 ending June 30, 2020.

11 Section 10. The sum of \$107,392,600, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
13 Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants to service  
14 providers for cost of living adjustments and rate increases  
15 associated with changes in the minimum wage.

16 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
18 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of Human  
19 Services for income assistance and related distributive  
20 purposes, including such Federal funds as are made available
