SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$2,100,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Public Health Association for the distribution of pre-exposure prophylaxis information. Effective July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$2,100,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Public Health Association for, in
7 partnership with the Southern Illinois School of Medicine's
8 Office of Community Initiatives and Complex Care, the
9 distribution, and grants and administrative expenses relating
10 to the distribution, of pre-exposure prophylaxis information
11 on HIV prevention, prevention of sexually transmitted diseases,
12 and the promotion of men's health in rural Illinois and the
13 Metro East area, with a concentration of effort on minority
14 populations in those geographic areas.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2020.
