SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-412

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that, for a vehicle that can obtain a registration sticker related to the exemption from window treatment requirements, the Secretary of State shall make the registration sticker available for any license plate offered by the Secretary.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 3-412 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-412) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412)

7 Sec. 3-412. Registration plates or digital registration
8 plates and registration stickers or digital registration
9 stickers to be furnished by the Secretary of State.

10 (a) The Secretary of State upon registering a vehicle
11 subject to annual registration for the first time shall issue
12 or shall cause to be issued to the owner one registration plate
13 or digital registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer,
14 semitrailer, moped, autocycle, or truck-tractor, 2
15 registration plates, or a digital registration plate and metal
16 plate as set forth in Section 3-401.5, for other motor vehicles
17 and, where applicable, current registration stickers or
18 digital registration stickers for motor vehicles of the first
19 division. The provisions of this Section may be made applicable
20 to such vehicles of the second division, as the Secretary of
21 State may, from time to time, in his discretion designate. On
22 subsequent annual registrations during the term of the
23 registration plate or digital registration plate as provided in

1 Section 3-414.1, the Secretary shall issue or cause to be
2 issued registration stickers or digital registration stickers
3 as evidence of current registration. However, the issuance of
4 annual registration stickers or digital registration stickers
5 to vehicles registered under the provisions of Sections 3-402.1
6 and 3-405.3 of this Code may not be required if the Secretary
7 deems the issuance unnecessary.

8 (b) Every registration plate or digital registration plate
9 shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned
10 to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of this State,
11 which may be abbreviated, the year number for which it was
12 issued, which may be abbreviated, the phrase "Land of Lincoln"
13 (except as otherwise provided in this Code), and such other
14 letters or numbers as the Secretary may prescribe. However, for
15 apportionment plates issued to vehicles registered under
16 Section 3-402.1 and fleet plates issued to vehicles registered
17 under Section 3-405.3, the phrase "Land of Lincoln" may be
18 omitted to allow for the word "apportioned", the word "fleet",
19 or other similar language to be displayed. Registration plates
20 or digital registration plates issued to a vehicle registered
21 as a fleet vehicle may display a designation determined by the
22 Secretary.

23 The Secretary may in his discretion prescribe that letters
24 be used as prefixes only on registration plates or digital
25 registration plates issued to vehicles of the first division
26 which are registered under this Code and only as suffixes on

1 registration plates or digital registration plates issued to
2 other vehicles. Every registration sticker or digital
3 registration sticker issued as evidence of current
4 registration shall designate the year number for which it is
5 issued and such other letters or numbers as the Secretary may
6 prescribe and shall be of a contrasting color with the
7 registration plates or digital registration plates and
8 registration stickers or digital registration stickers of the
9 previous year.

10 (c) Each registration plate or digital registration plate
11 and the required letters and numerals thereon, except the year
12 number for which issued, shall be of sufficient size to be
13 plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight,
14 and shall be coated with reflectorizing material. The
15 dimensions of the plate issued to vehicles of the first
16 division shall be 6 by 12 inches.

17 (d) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger
18 motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of
19 registration plates or digital registration plates as the type
20 of plates issued for a private passenger vehicle.

21 (e) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger
22 car used as a taxicab or livery, distinctive registration
23 plates or digital registration plates.

24 (f) The Secretary of State shall issue for every motorcycle
25 distinctive registration plates or digital registration plates
26 distinguishing between motorcycles having 150 or more cubic

1 centimeters piston displacement, or having less than 150 cubic
2 centimeter piston displacement.

3 (g) Registration plates or digital registration plates
4 issued to vehicles for-hire may display a designation as
5 determined by the Secretary that such vehicles are for-hire.

6 (h) (Blank).

7 (i) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and
8 private ambulance registration plates or digital registration
9 plates identifying the vehicle as an ambulance. The Secretary
10 shall forward to the Department of Healthcare and Family
11 Services registration information for the purpose of
12 verification of claims filed with the Department by ambulance
13 owners for payment for services to public assistance
14 recipients.

15 (j) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and
16 private medical carrier or rescue vehicle livery registration
17 plates or digital registration plates displaying numbers
18 within ranges of numbers reserved respectively for medical
19 carriers and rescue vehicles. The Secretary shall forward to
20 the Department of Healthcare and Family Services registration
21 information for the purpose of verification of claims filed
22 with the Department by owners of medical carriers or rescue
23 vehicles for payment for services to public assistance
24 recipients.

25 (k) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive license
26 plates or digital registration plates or distinctive license

1 plate stickers or digital registration stickers for every
2 vehicle exempted from subsections (a) and (a-5) of Section
3 12-503 by subsection (g) of that Section, and by subsection
4 (g-5) of that Section before its deletion by this amendatory
5 Act of the 95th General Assembly. The Secretary shall issue
6 these plates or stickers immediately upon receiving the
7 physician's certification required under subsection (g) of
8 Section 12-503. New plates or stickers shall also be issued
9 when the certification is renewed as provided in that
10 subsection. If a vehicle is eligible for a sticker issued under
11 this subsection, the Secretary shall make the sticker available
12 for any license plate offered by the Secretary.

13 (l) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive
14 registration plates or digital registration plates for
15 low-speed vehicles.

16 (m) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive
17 registration plates or digital registration plates for
18 autocycles. The dimensions of the plate issued to autocycles
19 shall be 4 by 7 inches.
