#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 330/8d new  
210 ILCS 5/7d new  
210 ILCS 85/6.28 new  
225 ILCS 85/15.10 new

Amends the University of Illinois Hospital Act, the Ambulatory Surgical Treatment Center Act, the Hospital Licensing Act, and the Pharmacy Practice Act. Requires hospitals, facilities, and pharmacies to offer a patient any unused portion of a facility-provided medication upon discharge when it is administered to a patient at the hospital, facility, or pharmacy and is required for continuing treatment. Defines "facility-provided medication".

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Hospital Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 8d as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 330/8d new)

7 Sec. 8d. Facility-provided medication upon discharge.

8 (a) The General Assembly finds that this Section is  
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
10 health, and safety.

11 (b) In this Section, "facility-provided medication" has  
12 the same meaning as provided under Section 15.10 of the  
13 Pharmacy Practice Act.

14 (c) When a facility-provided medication is administered to  
15 a patient at the University of Illinois Hospital, any unused  
16 portion of the facility-provided medication must be offered to  
17 the patient upon discharge when it is required for continuing  
18 treatment.

19 (d) A facility-provided medication shall be labeled  
20 consistent with labeling requirements under Section 33 of the  
21 Medical Practice Act of 1987.

22 Section 10. The Ambulatory Surgical Treatment Center Act is

1 amended by adding Section 7d as follows:

2 (210 ILCS 5/7d new)

3 Sec. 7d. Facility-provided medication upon discharge.

4 (a) The General Assembly finds that this Section is  
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
6 health, and safety.

7 (b) In this Section, "facility-provided medication" has  
8 the same meaning as provided under Section 15.10 of the  
9 Pharmacy Practice Act.

10 (c) When a facility-provided medication is administered to  
11 a patient at a facility licensed under this Act, any unused  
12 portion of the facility-provided medication must be offered to  
13 the patient upon discharge when it is required for continuing  
14 treatment.

15 (d) A facility-provided medication shall be labeled  
16 consistent with labeling requirements under Section 33 of the  
17 Medical Practice Act of 1987.

18 Section 15. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by adding  
19 Section 6.28 as follows:

20 (210 ILCS 85/6.28 new)

21 Sec. 6.28. Facility-provided medication upon discharge.

22 (a) The General Assembly finds that this Section is  
23 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

1 health, and safety.

2 (b) In this Section, "facility-provided medication" has  
3 the same meaning as provided under Section 15.10 of the  
4 Pharmacy Practice Act.

5 (c) When a facility-provided medication is administered to  
6 a patient at a hospital licensed under this Act, any unused  
7 portion of the facility-provided medication must be offered to  
8 the patient upon discharge when it is required for continuing  
9 treatment.

10 (d) A facility-provided medication shall be labeled  
11 consistent with labeling requirements under Section 33 of the  
12 Medical Practice Act of 1987.

13 Section 20. The Pharmacy Practice Act is amended by adding  
14 Section 15.10 as follows:

15 (225 ILCS 85/15.10 new)

16 Sec. 15.10. Facility-provided medication upon discharge.

17 (a) The General Assembly finds that this Section is  
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
19 health, and safety.

20 (b) In this Section, "facility-provided medication" means  
21 any topical antibiotic, anti-inflammatory, dilation, or  
22 glaucoma drop or ointment.

23 (c) When a facility-provided medication is administered to  
24 a patient at a pharmacy, any unused portion of the

1 facility-provided medication must be offered to the patient  
2 upon discharge when it is required for continuing treatment.

3 (d) A facility-provided medication shall be labeled  
4 consistent with labeling requirements under Section 33 of the  
5 Medical Practice Act of 1987.
