SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 5/9.18 new

Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that any facility that emits a carcinogen in this State must have a CAAPP permit. Defines "carcinogen". Effective January 1, 2021.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
5 adding Section 9.18 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 5/9.18 new)

7 Sec. 9.18. Carcinogens; CAAPP permit.

8 (a) Any facility that emits a carcinogen in this State must
9 have a CAAPP permit.

10 (b) In this Section, "carcinogen" means a substance listed
11 under Group A of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's
12 carcinogen risk assessment guidelines.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
14 1, 2021.
