

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 SB3643

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/9 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Provides that the month of November of each year is designated as Native American Heritage Month to be observed throughout the State as a month to recognize the contributions and influence of Native Americans on American history, achievement, culture, and innovation. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/9 new)
- November of each year is designated as Native American Heritage

  Month to be observed throughout the State as a month to

  recognize the contributions and influence of Native Americans

  on American history, achievement, culture, and innovation.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
