SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

SC0007

Introduced 2/13/2019, by Sen. Dan McConchie

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 8

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that appropriation bills shall require passage by a three-fifths vote in each house of the General Assembly. Effective upon being declared adopted.

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to amend Section 8 of Article IV of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

10	ARTICLE	IV

11 THE LEGISLATURE

12 (ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 8)

13 SECTION 8. PASSAGE OF BILLS

(a) The enacting clause of the laws of this State shall be:
"Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly."

(b) The General Assembly shall enact laws only by bill.
Bills may originate in either house, but may be amended or
rejected by the other.

(c) No bill shall become a law without the concurrence of a majority of the members elected to each house. Final passage of a bill shall be by record vote. In the Senate at the request of two members, and in the House at the request of five members, a record vote may be taken on any other occasion. A record vote
 is a vote by yeas and nays entered on the journal.

3 (d) A bill shall be read by title on three different days 4 in each house. A bill and each amendment thereto shall be 5 reproduced and placed on the desk of each member before final 6 passage.

Bills, except bills for appropriations and for the codification, revision or rearrangement of laws, shall be confined to one subject. Appropriation bills shall be limited to the subject of appropriations, and shall require passage by a three-fifths vote in each house of the General Assembly.

12 A bill expressly amending a law shall set forth completely13 the sections amended.

14 The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the 15 President of the Senate shall sign each bill that passes both 16 houses to certify that the procedural requirements for passage 17 have been met.
