5 WHEREAS, Paul Slivinski was born in Chicago to immigrant 6 parents from Lithuania on May 5, 1926; and

7 WHEREAS, Paul Slivinski lived his life admirably and 8 passionately; he served in the United States Navy during World 9 War II; he touched many lives as a biology teacher at St. 10 Ignatius College Prep in Chicago and as a school principal at 11 Pershing School in Berwyn; and

12 WHEREAS, Paul Slivinski was known as a creative actor and 13 artist who lived his life abundantly and with purpose; he was 14 guided by Alan Wilson Watts, the British-American philosopher 15 who interpreted and popularized Eastern philosophy for a 16 Western audience; in particular, he followed Watts' adage, "If 17 you go off into a far forest and get very quiet, you'll come to 18 understand that you are connected to everything"; and
