1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Gilbert "Sonny" Virgil Short of Moline, 4 who passed away on May 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Gilbert Short was born to Gale Gilbert and Alzora (Hoskins) Short in Moline on March 12, 1938; he grew up on his family's farm in Rock Island County and later in Mercer County and graduated from Joy High School in 1956; after graduation, Gilbert joined the U.S. Navy; and

WHEREAS, Gilbert Short farmed near Joy and worked as a welder, as well as a sand and gravel truck driver in California; in 1968, he founded A-1 Fire Equipment in Moline and later moved his business to Davenport, Iowa; he led his company for the next 36 years until his retirement from the fire protection equipment business in 2004; and

WHEREAS, Gilbert Short founded Speedway Fire and Rescue, a volunteer fire department specializing in motorsports rescue; for over 50 years, he worked to expand the organization with dozens of professionally trained members working at several racetracks around the region nearly every night of the week; he was also an active member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary as a Flotilla Commander along the Mississippi and Rock Rivers; and
