- 22 Sec. 7-139.14. Transfer to Article 3 pension fund.
- 23 (a) Within 6 months after the effective date of this
- 24 amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly, an active member
- 25 of a pension fund established under Article 3 of this Code may

1	apply for transfer to that Article 3 pension fund of his or her
2	credits and creditable service accumulated in this Fund for
3	service as a sheriff's law enforcement employee, person
4	employed by a participating municipality to perform police
5	duties, or law enforcement officer employed on a full-time
6	basis by a forest preserve district. The creditable service
7	shall be transferred only upon payment by this Fund to such
8	Article 3 pension fund of an amount equal to:
9	(1) the amounts accumulated to the credit of the
10	applicant for the service to be transferred, including
11	interest; and
12	(2) an amount representing employer contributions,
13	equal to the total amount determined under item (1); and
14	(3) any interest paid by the applicant to reinstate
15	such service.
16	Participation in this Fund as to any credits transferred
17	under this Section shall terminate on the date of transfer.
18	(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, any
19	person applying to transfer service under this Section may
20	reinstate credits and creditable service terminated upon
21	receipt of a separation benefit by paying to the Fund the
22	amount of the separation benefit plus interest thereon at the
23	actuarially assumed rate of interest to the date of payment.
24	Such payment must be made within 90 days after notification by
25	the Fund of the cost of such reinstatement.

- Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding 1
- 2 Section 8.45 as follows:
- 3 (30 ILCS 805/8.45 new)
- 4 Sec. 8.45. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and
- 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for 5
- the implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory 6
- Act of the 102nd General Assembly. 7
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law.". 9
