1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 12-4.54 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/12-4.54 new)
- 7 Sec. 12-4.54. SNAP, WIC; diapers, menstrual hygiene products. If the United States Department of Agriculture's 8 9 Food and Nutrition Service creates and makes available to the states a waiver permitting recipients of benefits provided 10 under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program or the 11 12 Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and 13 Children to use their benefits to purchase diapers or 14 menstrual hygiene products such as tampons, sanitary napkins, and feminine wipes, then the Department of Human Services 15 16 shall apply for the waiver. If the United States Department of 17 Agriculture approves the Department of Human Services' waiver application, then the Department of Human Services shall adopt 18 19 rules and make other changes as necessary to implement the 20 approved waiver.
