SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/107 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Provides that the 16th day of July of each year is designated a commemorative holiday to be known as Atomic Veterans Day and to be observed throughout the State as a day in honor and remembrance of the men and women of this Nation who during their time of service experienced exposure to nuclear radiation while on active duty and served so valiantly in the cause of freedom.

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 107 as follows:

7 Sec. 107. Atomic Veterans Day. The 16th day of July of each
8 year is designated a commemorative holiday to be known as
9 Atomic Veterans Day and to be observed throughout the State as
10 a day in honor and remembrance of the men and women of this
11 Nation who during their time of service experienced exposure
12 to nuclear radiation while on active duty and served so
13 valiantly in the cause of freedom.
