1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 2-3.163 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.163)
- 7 Sec. 2-3.163. Prioritization of Urgency of Need for
- 8 Services database.
- 9 (a) The General Assembly makes all of the following
- 10 findings:
- 11 (1) The Department of Human Services maintains a
- 12 statewide database known as the Prioritization of Urgency
- of Need for Services that records information about
- 14 individuals with developmental disabilities who are
- potentially in need of services.
- 16 (2) The Department of Human Services uses the data on
- 17 Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services to select
- individuals for services as funding becomes available, to
- develop proposals and materials for budgeting, and to plan
- for future needs.
- 21 (3) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services is
- 22 available for children and adults with a developmental
- disability who have an unmet service need anticipated in

- (4) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services is the first step toward getting developmental disabilities services in this State. If individuals are not on the Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services waiting list, they are not in queue for State developmental disabilities services.
- (5) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services may be underutilized by children and their parents or quardians due to lack of awareness or lack of information.
- (b) The State Board of Education may work with school districts to inform all students with developmental and their parents or quardians disabilities about Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services database.
- (c) Subject to appropriation, the Department of Human Services and State Board of Education shall develop and implement an online, computer-based training program for at least one designated employee in every public school in this State to educate him or her about the Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services database and steps to be taken to ensure children and adolescents are enrolled. The training shall include instruction for at least one designated employee every public school in contacting the appropriate developmental disabilities Independent Service Coordination agency to enroll children and adolescents in the database. At least one designated employee in every public school shall

- ensure the opportunity to enroll in the Prioritization of 1
- 2 Urgency of Need for Services database is discussed during
- 3 annual individualized education program (IEP) meetings for all
- children and adolescents believed to have a developmental 4
- 5 disability.
- 6 (d) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the
- 7 Department of Human Services, through school districts, shall
- 8 provide to inform parents and quardians of students a copy of
- 9 the Department of Human Services's guide titled "Understanding
- PUNS: A Guide to Prioritization for Urgency of Need for 10
- 11 Services" each year at the annual review meeting for the
- 12 student's individualized education program through school
- districts about the Prioritization of Urgency of Need for 13
- Services waiting list, including the consideration required in 14
- 15 subsection (e) of this Section.
- 16 (e) The Department of Human Services shall consider the
- 17 length of time spent on the Prioritization of Urgency of Need
- for Services waiting list, in addition to other factors 18
- considered, when selecting individuals on the list for 19
- 20 services.
