

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 120 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/120 new)

7 Sec. 120. Adjunct professor; status of class.

8 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
9 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board of  
10 Trustees must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
11 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
12 teach.

13 (b) The Board of Trustees shall allow an adjunct professor  
14 to have access to the electronic class roster that displays  
15 class enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the  
16 class.

17 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
18 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
19 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
20 Emergency Management Agency Act.

21 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on  
22 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General  
23 Assembly are exempt from the requirements of this Section.

1 Section 10. The Southern Illinois University Management  
2 Act is amended by adding Section 100 as follows:

3 (110 ILCS 520/100 new)

4 Sec. 100. Adjunct professor; status of class.

5 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
6 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
7 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
8 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
9 teach.

10 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
11 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
12 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

13 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
14 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
15 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
16 Emergency Management Agency Act.

17 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on  
18 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General  
19 Assembly are exempt from the requirements of this Section.

20 Section 15. The Chicago State University Law is amended by  
21 adding Section 5-210 as follows:

22 (110 ILCS 660/5-210 new)

1       Sec. 5-210. Adjunct professor; status of class.

2       (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
3 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
4 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
5 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
6 teach.

7       (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
8 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
9 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

10       (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
11 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
12 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
13 Emergency Management Agency Act.

14       (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

20       Sec. 10-210. Adjunct professor; status of class.

21       (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
22 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
23 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
24 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to

1 teach.

2 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
3 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
4 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

5 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
6 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
7 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
8 Emergency Management Agency Act.

9 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

15 Sec. 15-210. Adjunct professor; status of class.

17 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
18 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
19 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
20 teach.

21 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
22 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
23 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

24 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has

1 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
2 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
3 Emergency Management Agency Act.

4 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

9 (110 ILCS 675/20-215 new)

10 Sec. 20-215. Adjunct professor; status of class.

11 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
12 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
13 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
14 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
15 teach.

16 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
17 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
18 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

19 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
20 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
21 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
22 Emergency Management Agency Act.

23 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

5 Sec. 25-210. Adjunct professor; status of class.

6 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
7 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
8 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
9 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
10 teach.

11 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
12 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
13 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

14 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
15 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
16 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
17 Emergency Management Agency Act.

18 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

4 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
5 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of  
6 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
7 teach.

8 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
9 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
10 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

11 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
12 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
13 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
14 Emergency Management Agency Act.

15 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on

21 Sec. 35-215. Adjunct professor; status of class.

22 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
23 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the Board  
24 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of

1 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
2 teach.

3 (b) The Board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
4 access to the electronic class roster that displays class  
5 enrollment to assist in assessing the status of the class.

6 (c) This Section does not apply if the Governor has  
7 declared a disaster due to a public health emergency or a  
8 natural disaster pursuant to Section 7 of the Illinois  
9 Emergency Management Agency Act.

10 (d) Collective bargaining agreements that are in effect on  
11 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General

13 Section 50. The Public Community College Act is amended by  
14 adding Section 3-29.14 as follows:

15 (110 ILCS 805/3-29.14 new)

16 Sec. 3-29.14. Adjunct professor; status of class.

17 (a) At least 30 days before the beginning of a term and  
18 again at 14 days before the beginning of the term, the board  
19 must notify an adjunct professor about the status of class  
20 enrollment of the class the adjunct professor was hired to  
21 teach.

22 (b) The board shall allow an adjunct professor to have  
23 access to the electronic class roster that displays enrollment  
24 to assist in assessing the status of the class.
