SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.73 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.67 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that within 7 days after receiving information that a public school employee is charged with a sex offense, the school board shall notify, in writing, the parents or guardians of the school's students. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.73 and 34-18.67 as follows:

7 Sec. 10-20.73. Notice of sex offense charge against an
8 employee. Within 7 days after receiving information that a
9 school employee is charged with a sex offense, as defined
10 under the Sex Offender Registration Act, the school board
11 shall notify, in writing, the parents or guardians of the
12 school's students.

13 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.67 new)

14 Sec. 34-18.67. Notice of sex offense charge against an
15 employee. Within 7 days after receiving information that a
16 school employee is charged with a sex offense, as defined
17 under the Sex Offender Registration Act, the board shall
18 notify, in writing, the parents or guardians of the school's
19 students.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
21 becoming law.
