SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-506 625 ILCS 5/3-699.22 new 625 ILCS 5/3-802

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-802

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the Secretary of State to issue Force Combat Action Medal license plates to residents who have been awarded the Air Force Combat Action Medal. Makes conforming changes. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Sections 3-506 and 3-802 and by adding Section 6 3-699.22 as follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/3-506)

Sec. 3-506. Transfer of plates to spouses of military 8 9 service members. Upon the death of a military service member who has been issued a special plate under Section 3-609.1, 10 3-620, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 11 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, 3-666, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 12 3-676, 3-677, 3-680, 3-681, 3-683, 3-686, 3-688, 3-693, 3-698, 13 14 3-699.12, or 3-699.17, or 3-699.22 of this Code, the surviving spouse of that service member may retain the plate so long as 15 16 that spouse is a resident of Illinois and transfers the 17 registration to his or her name within 180 days of the death of the service member. 18

For the purposes of this Section, "service member" means any individual who is serving or has served in any branch of the United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard or other reserve components of the Armed Forces, and has been issued a special plate listed in this Section. - 2 - LRB102 10333 RAM 15660 b

2 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.22 new) 3 Sec. 3-699.22. Air Force Combat Action Medal license 4 plates. 5 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 6 7 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Air Force Combat Action Medal license plates 8 9 to residents of this State who have been awarded the Air Force 10 Combat Action Medal. The special Air Force Combat Action Medal 11 plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and 12 13 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 14 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire 15 according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by 16 Section 3-414.1. (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 17 18 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 19 20 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 21 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 22 designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412. The Secretary shall approve and prescribe 23 24 stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.

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3 (a) Definitions. For the purposes of this Section, the 4 following words shall have the meanings ascribed to them as

Sec. 3-802. Reclassifications and upgrades.

6 "Reclassification" means changing the registration of 7 a vehicle from one plate category to another.

8 "Upgrade" means increasing the registered weight of a 9 vehicle within the same plate category.

10 (b) When reclassing the registration of a vehicle from one 11 plate category to another, the owner shall receive credit for 12 the unused portion of the present plate and be charged the 13 current portion fees for the new plate. In addition, the 14 appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees 15 shall be assessed.

16 (b-5) Any Beginning with the 2019 registration year, any 17 individual who has a registration issued under either Section 3-405 or 3-405.1 that gualifies for a special license plate 18 under Section 3-609, 3-609.1, 3-620, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 19 20 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, 3-664, 3-666, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 3-676, 3-677, 3-680, 21 22 3-681, 3-683, 3-686, 3-688, 3-693, 3-698, 3-699.12, or 23 3-699.17, or 3-699.22 may reclass his or her registration upon acquiring a special license plate listed in this subsection 24 25 (b-5) without a replacement plate or digital plate fee or 26 registration sticker or digital registration sticker cost.

(b-10) Any Beginning with the 2019 registration year, any 1 2 individual who has a special license plate issued under Section 3-609, 3-609.1, 3-620, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, 4 3-664, 3-666, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 3-676, 3-677, 3-680, 3-681, 5 3-683, 3-686, 3-688, 3-693, 3-698, 3-699.12, or 3-699.17, or 6 7 3-699.22 may reclass his or her special license plate upon acquiring a new registration under Section 3-405 or 3-405.1 8 9 without a replacement plate or digital plate fee or 10 registration sticker or digital registration sticker cost.

11 (c) When upgrading the weight of a registration within the 12 same plate category, the owner shall pay the difference in 13 current period fees between the <u>2</u> two plates. In addition, the 14 appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees 15 shall be assessed. In the event new plates are not required, 16 the corrected registration card fee shall be assessed.

17 (d) In the event the owner of the vehicle desires to change the registered weight and change the plate category, the owner 18 shall receive credit for the 19 unused portion of the 20 registration fee of the current plate and pay the current portion of the registration fee for the new plate, and in 21 22 addition, pay the appropriate replacement plate and 23 replacement sticker fees.

(e) Reclassing from one plate category to another plate
category can be done only once within any registration period.
(f) No refunds shall be made in any of the circumstances

found in subsection (b), subsection (c), or subsection (d); however, when reclassing from a flat weight plate to an apportioned plate, a refund may be issued if the credit amounts to an overpayment.

5 (g) In the event the registration of a vehicle registered 6 under the mileage tax option is revoked, the owner shall be 7 required to pay the annual registration fee in the new plate 8 category and shall not receive any credit for the mileage 9 plate fees.

10 (h) Certain special interest plates may be displayed on 11 first division vehicles, second division vehicles weighing 12 8,000 pounds or less, and recreational vehicles. Those plates 13 can be transferred within those vehicle groups.

(i) Plates displayed on second division vehicles weighing
8,000 pounds or less and passenger vehicle plates may be
reclassed from one division to the other.

(j) Other than in subsection (i), reclassing from one division to the other division is prohibited. In addition, a reclass from a motor vehicle to a trailer or a trailer to a motor vehicle is prohibited.
