Amends the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act. Makes a change in a Section concerning the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority.

1 AN ACT concerning the State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3930/4) (from Ch. 38, par. 210-4)
- Sec. 4. Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority; 8 creation, membership, and meetings. There is created an 9 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority consisting of 25 members. The The membership of the Authority shall consist 10 of the Illinois Attorney General, or his or her designee, the 11 Director of Corrections, the Director of State Police, the 12 Director of Public Health, the Director of Children and Family 13 14 Services, the Sheriff of Cook County, the State's Attorney of Cook County, the clerk of the circuit court of Cook County, the 15 16 President of the Cook County Board of Commissioners, the 17 Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department, the Director of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, 18 the Executive Director of the Illinois Law Enforcement 19 20 Training Standards Board, the State Appellate Defender, the 21 Public Defender of Cook County, and the following additional 22 members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Governor: a circuit court clerk, a sheriff, a State's Attorney of a county 23

- other than Cook, a Public Defender of a county other than Cook,
- 2 a chief of police, and 6 members of the general public.
- 3 Members appointed on and after the effective date of this
- 4 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly shall be confirmed
- 5 by the Senate.
- 6 The Governor from time to time shall designate a Chairman
- 7 of the Authority from the membership. All members of the
- 8 Authority appointed by the Governor shall serve at the
- 9 pleasure of the Governor for a term not to exceed 4 years. The
- 10 initial appointed members of the Authority shall serve from
- January, 1983 until the third Monday in January, 1987 or until
- 12 their successors are appointed.
- 13 The Authority shall meet at least quarterly, and all
- 14 meetings of the Authority shall be called by the Chairman.
